THE SCHOOL EMBLEM



Comprises of the Greek alphabets – "Alpha" (α) and "Omega" (Ω), a Sword, a Lotus, a Lamp, a Book and words" – *In Verbo Veritatis*" meaning "In the Word is Truth".

The words Alpha and Omega in Greek denotes God who is the Beginning and the End. Children in this School are reminded all the time that they should attribute their success which originates from God from the beginning to the End and they should be grateful to God.
